AFFORDABILITY

- Harvard offers need-based financial aid which is based on your family's financial circumstances. Families that make under \$85K a year will pay \$0 for their child's Harvard education.
- Harvard's aid is awarded in grants—this is money you do not have to pay back. Loans are not required at Harvard, and 3/4ths of students choose not to borrow. Some students take out loans to pay for college which is money they will pay back over time.
