## ACADEMICS

- **CHOOSE** one out of 50 academic areas to study in depth—this will be your “concentration” at Harvard.
- **LEARN** from professors who are experts in their field and want to share knowledge through hands-on learning settings such as a laboratory, museum, or classroom.
- **STUDY** in another country for a semester or summer—in fact, 2/3rds of Harvard students do!
- **ENGAGE** with your three advisers who can help you pick classes and adjust to life at Harvard.



## RESIDENTIAL LIFE

- **LIVE** in one of the 12 Houses (Harvard dormitories) with roommates from all over the world and find a tight-knit community of friends.
- **EXPERIENCE** Harvard traditions such as the annual Harvard-Yale football game, Housing Day, or Yardfest.
- **TRY** new activities; dance, sports, theater, community service, cultural groups, journalism, politics, and much more!
- **EXPLORE** Cambridge/Boston; go to baseball games, learn about the city’s history, stroll through museums, try new restaurants, or walk through the parks and along the Charles River.



# AFFORDABILITY

- Harvard offers **need-based financial aid** which is based on your family's financial circumstances. Families that **make under \$85K a year will pay \$0** for their child's Harvard education.
- Harvard's aid is awarded in grants—**this is money you do not have to pay back. Loans are not required at Harvard**, and 3/4ths of students choose not to borrow. Some students take out loans to pay for college which is money they will pay back over time.
